



Invitation to IFFA Workshop in Oslo 20-21 October 2015

The International Family Forestry Alliance, IFFA, invites all members and partners to participate in a Workshop in Oslo, Norway Tuesday 20 and Wednesday 21 October 2015.

The subject of the workshop is:

Policies and Programmes which encourage increased production of timber from family forests and small producers

There will be a comparison of experience from Canada, Norway, Sweden, Finland, and other European countries and the lessons learned for forest producer organisations globally.

After the workshop, there will be a two-day excursion to regional forest producer organisations in Norway and Sweden (22-23 October).

The workshop will be hosted by the Norwegian Forest Owners' Federation, in collaboration with IFFA and the Forest and Farm Facility, and organised in the Centre of Oslo Norway.

The participants must be prepared to cover their travel and lodging costs, but a travel support for participants from economies under development may be available.
